The Georgia Boy Choir operates on a five-tiered system of musical education for boys as young as five years old through high school. Membership in the Choir is by audition only. Auditions are intentionally low-pressure. Each boy is asked to sing a song—any song he likes; it can be something as simple as "Twinkle, Twinkle Little Star" or even "Happy Birthday," or maybe something he has learned in school or church. We will then sing some musical phrases and ask him to repeat them, then play a few notes on the piano and ask him to respond. It is fairly simple and only takes a few minutes. Regardless of each boy's experience and preparedness, this process reveals a great deal about each individual and allows us easily to discern his level of natural ability. Most boys seem to enjoy the experience. Auditions for the Georgia Boy Choir are held three times per year, in the fall, winter, and spring.
